Set up a W8300 appliance

1 Before you begin

- a. Appliance boxes are ready for set up
- b. Redeem license keys for each appliance

Unpack, mount and power on the appliance box



- a. Unpack appliance and accessories
- b. Securely rack mount the appliance
- c. Make front and rear panel connections
- d. Power on each appliance

3 Set up remote access for each appliance box

Login

- a. Log into iDRAC with the default password
- b. Choose a new password

6 Upon successful installation



On successful installation, use the URL made available on the page to log into the ArcSight Platform application

5 Deploy the W8300 appliance



- a. User the URL (https://<your_hostname>:6443) and login information from step 4 g to create a user
- b. Log in as the user created in the last step and accept the OpenText EULA and RHEL EULA respectively
- c. Specify the NFS server and path and add nodes; a minimum of 3 nodes provides High Availability (HA).
- d. Configure a virtual hostname if there are 3 master nodes
- e. Configure the OMT password, and submit the configuration summary to start the installation
- f. Toggle 'Show logs' to see installation logs



4 Bootstrap the W8300 appliance



- a. Turn on the appliance from iDRAC
- b. Boot from your preferred RHEL version
- c. Log in with the default username (otadmin) and password, then change password
- d. Set passwords for both root and 'arcsight' users on the OpenText Appliance splash screen
- e. Select the network connection and configure a static IP address
- f. Configure the time server
- g. (Optional) Identify a W8300 node to deploy to a cluster
