New in this Release

The following new features were released in Exchange Web Service Connector version 12.7.0.

- The connector supports LDAP attributes containing mailbox full access SIDs. There is a new configuration parameter, `LDAPExchangeFullAccessSidProperties`, which accepts a comma-separated list of LDAP attribute names. The default value is `msExchMasterAccountSid`. When the connector constructs Access Control Lists (ACLs), the accounts specified by these LDAP attributes are given full access to everything in the mailbox.
- The connector can insert documents into Digital Safe, through the Digital Safe REST API, in EML format. To do this, configure `IngesterType=DigitalSafeREST` and `StoreBinaryAndMeta=FALSE`.

Resolved Issues

The following issues were resolved in Exchange Web Service Connector version 12.7.0.

- A fetch task would fail when processing an item that contained an attachment, if the attachment had no name.
- An issue with scheduling meant that tasks did not start at the correct time. The start of a task could be delayed, compared to the expected start time specified by the `ScheduleStartTime` parameter.
- Various `GetRequestLog` (GRL) HTML issues have been fixed:
 - Actions were not properly escaped in some places, which could allow malicious users to inject some alternative HTML in the `GetRequestLog` response.
 - The Open link in new window option did not work.
 - The auto refresh option would modify the selected open link option.
 - Links to the obsolete `confighelp` action have been removed.
 - The HTML page now uses a Content-Security-Policy to protect against malicious data injection by crafted actions sent to the server.

Notes

- `IngesterType=DigitalSafeSOAP` has been deprecated. Micro Focus recommends that you use `IngesterType=DigitalSafeREST` instead. `IngesterType=DigitalSafeSOAP` is still available for existing implementations, but it might be incompatible with new functionality. The functionality might be deleted in future.
