What's New

Voltage Database Activity Monitoring 24.3.0 release brings in a few new features and enhancements:

New Features

- Alert suppressing mechanism in VDAM Server to suppress repetitive alerts.
- SSL decryption for Oracle, PostgreSQL, and Hardware-accelerated (x86).
- Maintenance mode in VDAM collector for service corruption maintenance of large system.
- Distributed search capability using a single VDAM UI for various Search DB clusters/seeds.
- Notification groups for Scheduled Report functionality.
- Amazon Elastic S3 storage support
- Daily Information Report has now names of machines with no activity.
- Installation of Database Updater
- Trace File Manager to DSIM Tool to load multiple trace, sort, merge and export files for specific TCP sessions
- Archive features for NLog configuration settings, for which
 - A log file can be up to 50 MB in size.
 - A maximum of 10 log files, excluding current ones, can be retained and old files are compressed.
- Autopush policy, to automatically push DAM policies as per the lookup list.
- Email notifications, for the users in Notification Group in schedule reports and in case of an error in the preparation of reports.

Expand supported platforms

- Oracle for Windows and MySQL for VDAM Agents

Deprecations

- "statement_type" property has been removed across all Databases.
- capture_type field is deprecated for all DB parser except Oracle.

Fixed Issues

VDAM Agent:

- Solaris/IPNET capturing problem for some OS versions is solved that agents can now capture any traffic for an OS-Hardware combination.
- Fixed the Oracle parser to gather logs from different client-server combination.
- Fixed the UID chain for Windows and the CPU usage statistics.
- Fixed the HanaDB Statement Parsing that ensures the correct parser is selected.
- Version reporting issue is fixed for DSIM/Windows.

VDAM Collector

- The issues causing server hang-ups on the DSIM Server, particularly during event processing, have been resolved. Errors occurring during file reading, downloading, or event processing are now managed correctly.
- The issue where dump files were saved to the incorrect location when the dump folder path was not specified has been resolved.
- The issues identified in Sonarcloud concerning the DACollectorJob and the potential error-prone areas in parsers due to missing null checks for Stopwatch have been resolved.
- The error occurring when retrieving events for the dbgreenplum database has been fixed.

VDAM Console

- Crashing issues on HotDB button click in the date range selection panel on the Search screen and in the date filtering area on newly installed environments are fixed.
- Breakdown filters when displaying 10,000+ records will now be available on exporting to CSV feature.
- A time zone offset has been added to CSV exports obtained with the CSV Exporter.
- Resolved the issue where headers were displayed multiple times on the search results screen.
- Fixed the issue preventing the download of trace files.
- Resolved the issue where days imported from the archive were not displayed on the Dashboard.
