What's New Over the Last Two Years (Retain Versions 4.11–23.4)?

Branding Changes

Retain has now been rebranded to reflect our new corporate name, OpenText. This change impacts the name of products and components, user interfaces, logos, etc.

In addition to these changes, Retain has moved to a quarterly release cycle. This impacts the versioning of Retain. Each release will have a year and quarter version number with the 4th quarter release being long term. *i.e., 23.4 for the Long Term Support release in 2023, 4th quarter.* Our first change to the new versioning occurred between 4.11 and 23.2.

Retain has released 4 versions in last year: Retain 4.11, 23.2, 23.3, 23.4

SOLR 9

Retain 23.4 supports the Solr 9 indexer engine. This greatly improves the search performance for much faster results.

PLATFORM SUPPORT

Support for GroupWise 18.5 and 23.4 Upgrade Java to JDK 17

OAUTH FOR MICROSOFT 365

We've added support for modern authentication, OAuth, for Microsoft 365 users to access Retain Server.

Synchronize TrustStore for Remote Workers

Retain Server's TrustStore is shared with local and remote workers. Workers can connect to HTTPS-secured messaging systems and communication through HTTPS will be validated before running the archive job.

RUN JOB NOW

Retain now provides you an option to run a job immediately.

SECURE DATABASE CONNECTION

Retain now supports a secured connection between Retain and all the supported database types (MariaDB, MySQL, Oracle, PostgreSQL, and MSSQL).

SSL CERTIFICATE MANAGEMENT

You can now manage the self-signed certificates to be trusted in Retain. Also, an option to enable HTTPS validation is provided.

EXPORT AUDIT TABLE

We've added the option to *Hide Message Subject* on the Export Audit Table. This will allow you to hide or unhide the message subject in the Report.

PST Export

With PST exporting now built into the Retain Server, we have enhanced it further by allowing the jobs to be broken up by user.

Multi-Worker Jobs

New Worker Groups can be created an individual workers may be added to the group. When a job is created, it may be assigned to a group of works to service the job, spreading the load across multiple works for better efficiency.

Android Mobile Client

The Android Mobile Client has received updates to libraries and improved security. These improvements have been brought up to Google's latest standards.

SOLR 8 (Retain 4.11)

A new version of the Retain Indexer in version 4.11 is available. You'll need to step through here to update to our latest version. We recommend upgrading to Retain 23.4 in order to get SOLR 9 immediately following the successful SOLR 8 indexer upgrade. Contact Customer Care for more information.
